The newly constructed campus of CDTI is equipped with a state-of-the-art Cyber Lab and classrooms with advanced teaching aids such as digital smart Board, digital podium, syndicate discussion rooms and a modern interrogation room.

During the courses, emphasis is given to practical exercises, hands-on practices, field visits, panel discussions, and case studies. An auditorium having a seating capacity of 200 persons is used for organizing seminars, events, and for entertainment purposes of trainees, office staff, and their families.



An online classroom with advanced facilities such as digital smart board, digital podium, modern sound system, and latest audio-visual equipment is used for conducting classes and seminars. The institute has a modern and well-equipped library. It has the subscription of several e-journals and e-newspapers and provides access to an e-library through DELNET. It has a good collection of books on various subjects related to Counter-Terrorism, Human Rights, Forensic Science, and Cyber Crime and it has a vast collection of audio-visual training material which are useful for the trainees as well as the staff.



The Institute has a well-equipped Gymnasium, and sports facilities for indoor games such as table tennis, badminton, and the outdoor volleyball court. There is a green garden area for yoga and other physical activities of trainees, staff, and their families. The Institute also has a well-furnished hostel for male & female police officers, and a guest house besides a good cafeteria including mess. The campus boasts of more than 6000 plantations and is a 'Plastic free zone'.

Special attention is given to training police officers on mobile forensics and digital evidence. Officers are taught to acquire, preserve, investigate and depose digital evidence. Training is imparted on analysing call data records and Internet Protocols Detail Record.

1.	Investigation of Crime against Women and their safety-related issues	Courses are run for the training of police and prosecution officers in forensic science. Exposure is given on handling of the scene of crime, lifting fingerprints from the scene of crime, and related practical exercises on a collection of all physical evidence/clues. The trainees are given Hands-on Training in handling, labeling, and packaging of exhibits lifted from the scene of crime and other sources and sending the exhibits to related FSL within time. These courses have been designed to provide in-depth knowledge on the admissibility of Forensic evidence and also its judicial appreciation. To apprise the participants about the Do's and Don'ts in handling forensic evidence/errors committed by the IO's in handling cases etc.
